



THE MSC GROUP

Headquartered in Geneva, Switzerland, and privately owned, the MSC Group is a global business engaged in the transport and logistics sector. The Group encompasses a Cargo Division with MSC Mediterranean Shipping Company (MSC), Terminal Investment Limited (TiL), MEDLOG, MSC Air Cargo, AGL, Log-in, WEC Lines and Rimorchiatori Mediterranei, as well as a Passenger Division led by MSC Cruises, Explora Journeys, and complemented by Mediterranean passenger ferries with Grandi Navi Veloci (GNV) and SNAV. Italo joined the Group end of April 2024.

The MSC Group was founded in 1970 by Captain Gianluigi Aponte in Brussels, Belgium. Captain Aponte started the Company with one small conventional ship, the MV Patricia. As containerisation took place and the globalisation of the world economy evolved, MSC grew to become a leader in global container shipping.

In addition, in August 2023, MSC completed the acquisition of the hospital operator Mediclinic International as part of a consortium alongside Remgro Ltd.

The MSC Group's values have been expressed in substantial long-term partnerships over the years that actively engage in achieving meaningful change. The MSC Foundation was established as a private non-profit entity in 2018 to lead, focus, and advance these commitments.

Today, the Group employs over 200,000 people across the globe.

As a family company, we have built strong relationships with our customers, business partners and stakeholders, working together to address the global challenges of today as well as those of the future. Our dedication and passion, our reliability and resilience as a company are among the

reasons why our customers choose us and why local economies and producers rely on us to facilitate global trade.

The MSC Cargo Division's sustainability journey is guided by our roadmap and priorities: enabling logistics decarbonisation, fostering inclusive trade and addressing social challenges. Our annual Sustainability Report tells the story of this journey, describing how we are addressing our priorities and making a positive contribution to society and the planet.

MSC Cruises' journey toward sustainable cruises is organized around four key pillars: Planet, People, Place and Procurement. This translates into a drive to continuously

improve the fleet's environmental performance; caring for all employees and promoting diversity and inclusion; working to ensure that our impact on the coastal communities that we reach remains positive, and responsibly sourcing the products and services that we purchase. The latest Sustainability Report of MSC Cruises demonstrates how sustainability is at the heart of the business.

WE ARE IN THIS TOGETHER

Addressing complex global challenges requires concerted action and in today's world, no single actor can address these alone. At MSC we see sustainability as a collective journey and we are continuously exploring new opportunities to work with public and private partners to deliver on our commitments.

Decarbonizing our industry demands concrete action to scale the production and distribution as well as promote the adoption of low- and zero-carbon fuels and technologies. We capitalize on interdependencies across the transportation and logistics ecosystem, joining forces to align on common interests towards a shared vision, innovating to find solutions, pooling technical expertise and resources as well as sharing risk. Our active

participation in cross-sectoral partnerships and multistakeholder bodies alongside ongoing investments in research, trials and pilots are conducted in collaboration with others towards our net-zero target.

MSC Cruises collaborates with other industry leaders to research and develop new solutions, including with several EU funded projects that are investigating technical solutions for supporting decarbonization. These include research into the reduction of methane slip from LNG engines, fuel cell solutions as well as the CHEK Consortium, a collaborative effort funded by the EU Horizon 2020 fund that focuses on combining progressive energy technologies and forward-thinking ship design to promote low-carbon maritime operations.



CLIMATE ACTION WHILE PROTECTING OUR PLANET

As a leading company whose business both impacts and is impacted by our changing climate, MSC has a key role to play in accelerating the transition to a net-zero economy. We are committed to our decarbonization pathway towards the target of net-zero decarbonization by 2050. Since 2008 the MSC fleet has reduced its carbon intensity by more than 40%, while MSC Cruises has achieved a 33.5% reduction.

As our industry shifts to different energy sources, an interconnected set of social impacts is emerging that highlights the need for a just and equitable transition for

workers, businesses and communities. The journey to net-zero will catalyse efforts to accelerate new technologies and innovation with a direct impact on the creation of opportunities and new markets, the evolution of supply chains as well as the need for new jobs and skills.

Rising sea levels and more extreme weather events have major implications for our industry, including the way we manage risk as well as our climate adaptation activities and investments in resilient coastal and inland infrastructure.

OUR PATHWAY TO DECARBONIZATION

As part our decarbonization pathway, MSC is engaging in a massive overhaul of our assets, implementing an extensive fleet renewal plan as well as progressively adopting new fuels and technologies. Energy-efficient newbuilding vessels, inland vehicles and onshore equipment are being phased in, while others are being retrofitted with technologies, systems and infrastructure to accommodate low- and zero-carbon fuels.


MSC envisages a net-zero future that will see shipping draw on a combination of fuels, and our focus is on ensuring the readiness of our fleet to adopt zero-carbon fuels as they become available. Different solutions are required according to vessel type, size, service deployment, and necessary power output, and MSC is exploring and trialling a range of fuels and technologies to this end.

MSC is pursuing multiple solutions to accelerate the energy transition and to ensure the targets set by the business are met. These include the adoption of sustainable biofuel and Liquefied Natural Gas (LNG). In addition, synthetic and biomethanol and green ammonia may become fuel choices for larger vessels, while green hydrogen, batteries and fuel cells may be used for smaller vessels and short-sea shipping. MSC Cruises already has two LNG-fuelled ships sailing and is committed to investing in future LNG-fuelled ships, which will join the fleet in coming years. These LNG-fuelled ships will deliver a lower carbon footprint and significant reductions of nitrogen oxide and sulfur oxide (NOx and SOx) emissions compared with conventional propulsion. The results of this

investment and commitment have already been realized when MSC Cruises completed the industry's net-zero voyage in 2023 with the MSC Euribia.

At TiL we are keenly aware of our terminals' role in decarbonization and are continually reviewing our investment plans to ensure they consider our emissions reduction ambitions and operational efficiency improvement objectives. Our energy transition programme considers both reducing energy consumption through improvements in energy efficiency and reducing energy carbon content by reducing fossil fuel dependency. Throughout TIL's portfolio, where appropriate, we are implementing technical and operational improvements, shifting to electrical cargo handling equipment and sourcing electricity from renewable sources.

As a global logistics player, MEDLOG has a crucial role to play in decarbonizing logistics. Collaboration across the supply and value chain is key to enable the investments needed to decarbonize and accelerate solutions at scale. We are reducing our inland logistics carbon footprint through an intermodal strategy aimed at increasing carbon abatement, such as shifting from trucks to railway and/or inland waterways via barges and an expansion of MEDLOG's rail network throughout Europe.



Despite such unprecedented times, MSC continued to maintain a strong position across its cargo business, minimized disruptions to clients' supply chains and optimized their customer experience.

ADVANCING THE INDUSTRY THROUGH DIGITALIZATION AND SUSTAINABILITY

On the digitalization front, as a founding member of the Digital Container Shipping Association (DCSA), in February 2023 MSC committed to transitioning to committed to transition to 100% use of electronic Bills of Lading (eBLs) by 2030. This milestone represents a significant step forward for MSC, its customers and the industry. Meanwhile, in line with its commitment to net-zero decarbonization of its fleet by 2050, MSC prepared a range of robust measures to ensure compliance with the latest IMO regulations. This includes a new voyage optimization programme rolled out earlier this year, pursuing a range of alternative fuel solutions as well as modernizing its fleet through the industry-leading new building programme.

Over the years, MSC has invested in several initiatives and has further diversified its business-related activities. The Company has seen exponential growth in terms of both volume and fleet capacity, and now serves millions of customers globally, with a 365-days-a-year operation.

Today, our focus remains true to our roots, building and retaining long-term trusted partnerships with customers of all size and scale.

A MODERN, EFFICIENT FLEET

MSC operates one of the youngest fleets in the world, including some of the world's most low-carbon footprint vessels available today.

Our ultra large vessels (Gülsün Class and Celestino Maresca Class) help us in achieving economies of scale, resulting in lower carbon emissions per container carried. MSC launched its new record-breaking 24,000+ TEU Celestino Maresca class vessels in July 2023 - the biggest and most fuel-efficient containerships by design.

In recent years, MSC has made investments in LNG-fuelled vessels. In 2022, MSC saw its first four newbuilding dualfuel LNG-capable container vessels in operation. MSC is committed to maintaining a modern fleet that will advance progress towards net-zero decarbonization by replacing conventional fuel vessels with dual-fuel capable vessels in the short term, including those fuelled by LNG.

In addition to our substantial investment in new and technologically advanced vessels, we continue an extensive retrofit programme and other measures to achieve optimal efficiency. We also actively explore a range of alternative fuels and propulsion solutions that will help the business move even closer towards net-zero, and we see cross-industry collaboration as crucial to scaling these solutions for the maritime industry.

MSC SHIPMANAGEMENT

The technical management of MSC's vessels and crew management are handled by MSC Shipmanagement technical offices, respectively located in Limassol, Cyprus and Sorrento, Italy. The technical management of the ship includes the procurement of stores and spare parts, vessel maintenance, daily monitoring of vessel performance in terms of fuel efficiency, vessel condition assessment and upgrade, dry-dockings and retrofit projects, classification and regulatory compliance, assistance on insurance cases, optimization of new and existing vessels design for cargo handling, research and new building vessels supervision, research, design and construction.

The Company also manages crew training centres in India, Ukraine, Italy and Montenegro.

MSC Shipmanagement is one of the few companies whose entire operated fleet and shore office is accredited with ISO 9001 (Quality management), ISO 14001 (Environment management certification), ISO 50001 (Energy management system certification), ISO 27001 (Information security management system) and ISO 45001 (Occupational health & safety management standard).

HIGH-SPEED TRAIN FLEET

The Italo fleet comprises 25 cutting-edge AGV 575 trains and 26 Italo EVO trains. Both trains can travel at very high speeds, with the AGV 575 travelling up to 300 km/h and the EVO reaching a maximum speed of 250 km/h. All trains comply with the latest safety standard requirements. The Italo network connects 62 stations and 59 cities with 51 trains in a total of 118 daily trips: this broad coverage efficiently connects major Italian destinations from North to South.

A MODERN, REGULAR BUS FLEET

In May 2023, Italo enhanced its portfolio and acquired Itabus, a private long-distance coach company, Itabus offers intermodal services, including train and bus connections that link large cities, small towns and infrastructure hubs across Italy. With a fleet of 100 latestgeneration MAN vehicles, Itabus provides integrated mobility services, offering 2,200 daily connections and 500 daily departures from more than 85 Italian cities. The Itabus fleet offers a superior quality service with doubledecker buses (74 seats each) and two travel styles (Comfort+ or Top) and vehicles equipped with free 4G or 5G WI-FI, toilets, and on-board vending machines.

Since its foundation, Italo has made sustainability a core operating principle. The company has a strong innovative spirit and is known for its environmentally-friendly transportation; the trains are currently built with 98% recyclable materials. One of the MSC Foundation's longest partnerships is with UNICEF, generously supported by MSC Cruises' guests, who have donated \$14 million over the years. These funds have helped save 115,668 African children from severe acute malnutrition. An innovative programme launched in Côte d'Ivoire in 2019 has recycled 616,000 tonnes of plastic waste into bricks and used them to build 112 modern classrooms, enabling an additional 5,600 children to access education.

The MSC Foundation works with the Italian marine conservation organization Marevivo to provide youth education in the Mediterranean that has reached more than 7,316 island school children (Guardian Dolphins) and 4,297 Italian nautical institute secondary school students (Nauticinblu). Nauticinblu continues to grow internationally and is now delivering courses in Spain, Portugal, and Greece. In addition, 600,000 young people on MSC Cruises voyages engage in our onboard edutainment activities worldwide every year.





The MSC Foundation mobilizes substantial resources and donations to provide prompt humanitarian support in crises thanks to MSC's global reach and networks. It joins forces with key operational partners to facilitate transportation, and sometimes to directly provide food, non-food, and medical supplies that are essential for the survival and recovery of impacted communities. Recent examples of people reached include those at risk of contracting COVID-19 in more than 20 countries, people affected by Hurricane Dorian in the Bahamas, refugees and internally displaced persons from the war in Ukraine. and earthquake survivors in Türkiye and Syria.

SUPER CORAL PROGRAMME



OCEAN CAY, THE BAHAMAS

The MSC Foundation is working with a panel of internationally-renowned scientists and conservation experts to protect, restore and nurture 64 square miles of marine waters and ecosystems around Ocean Cay island in the Bahamas. Here, the Super Coral Programme is pioneering new coral reef conservation and restoration techniques to mitigate the impacts of climate change and sharing them worldwide. It will soon be supported in this work by the Marine Conservation Centre currently under construction.
