MSC Thermal Liners protect sensitive cargo against damage caused by temperature changes, moisture, condensation or contamination during transportation.

Made from a durable blend of aluminium and polyethylene, these insulated liners are specially designed bags that fit inside a 20' or 40' container.

They are ideal for commodities with a natural high moisture content, such as cocoa and coffee beans.

These products release moisture into the surrounding air, especially when there are fluctuations in temperature and humidity - leading to condensation, mould growth and spoilage.

To avoid any cargo damage and loss, it is important to maintain a stable environment inside the container throughout the transportation process.

DID YOU KNOW? The temperature inside a container can fluctuate from -25°C to +60°C.



HOW IT WORKS



Cargo is **loaded directly** into the MSC Thermal Liner, which covers every side of the container. Moisture absorbers are placed inside the thermal bag before stuffing to capture any moisture remnants. This ensures your goods never contact potential contaminants inside the container (e.g., pesticides, insects, odours, or past fumigations).

STUFFING

MSC Thermal Liner provides a layer of insulation for your cargo. It is made from highly reflective, food-grade material that helps maintain a **stable temperature** inside the container, drastically reducing the risk of temperature fluctuations and condensation damage.

SEALING

The MSC Thermal Liner offers weather protection by shielding commodities from direct exposure to different weather conditions including rain, sleet, snow and wind. This helps to maintain a consistent internal environment.

VACUUM PROCESS

This vacuum-sealing process also creates an "air gap" between the container walls and the commodity, creating an extra layer of insulation and a **lower risk of condensation**.

FINISH INSTALLATION

Our solution is equipped with a **special valve** that removes the air between the commodity and the thermal liner, eliminating a lot of moisture and helping to preserve the food.

DID YOU KNOW? Thermal liners have been proven to reduce the risk of fire for self heating commodities such as charcoal. The phenomenon of self heating occurs when the substance is submitted to temperature increase and the availability of oxygen. By vacuuming most of the oxygen out of the MSC Thermal Liner combined with the reflective properties of the thermal liner, we significantly minimize the risk of self combustion and help reduce temperature fluctuations.
