

FuelEU INTRODUCTION

The **FuelEU Maritime initiative** is part of the Fit for 55 package aiming to enable the EU to **reduce its net GHG emissions** by at least **55% by 2030** and to achieve climate **neutrality** in **2050**. The regulation was passed into law on 25 July 2023 and **applies from 1 January 2025**.

APPLICABILITY





per group of vessel / per year (pooling mechanism)

no phase in period (i.e. based on total quantity from the first year)



APPLICATION



WHEN: From 1 January 2025



WHO: For all commercial ships of **5,000 GT** and above, regardless their flag.




WHERE: For vessels calling **EU/EEA** countries



GHG - REDUCTION TARGETS

The average GHG intensity of the energy used onboard must be reduced every 5 years in line with intensity targets set by the EU, compared against a reference value of 91.16 gCO2e/MJ (grams of carbon dioxide equivalent per Megajoule)



Reduction

- -2% by 2025
- -6% by 2030
- -14.5% by 2035
- -31% by 2040
- -62% by 2045
- -80% by 2050
